
STUDENT SUPPORT UPDATE – JANUARY TO JUNE 2021


Snapshot – January to June 2021

A total of 147,678 students received student support, an increase of 6.0 percent compared to same period last year


133,101 students borrowed under the Student Loan (SL) scheme



8,325 more students received student support compared with the same period last year



The number of SL borrowers increased, while amount borrowed was steady




Note: Total amount covers borrowings for course fees, living costs, and course related costs only




