
STUDENT SUPPORT UPDATE – JANUARY TO MARCH 2021


Snapshot – January to March 2021

A total of 130,580 students were provided student support, an increase of 4.5 percent compared to same time last year


119,097 students borrowed under Student Loan (SL) Scheme



5,564 more students received students support compared with the same time last year



Student Loan (SL) Scheme – number of borrowers and amount borrowed increased




Student Allowances (SA) Scheme - number of recipients and amount of allowances paid increased




Average Student Allowance paid




Proportion of SL borrowers for living costs slightly increased




