## **Official Information Act Request**

Thank you for your email of 28 February 2024, requesting information regarding New Zealand Super (NZS) clients who also receive pensions from nations with which New Zealand does not have a reciprocal social security agreement.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Please find my decision set out below.

- 1. The number of recipients of NZ superannuation who also receive pension payments from any country with which NZ does not have a reciprocal pension agreement.
- 2. The number of the above who receive less than NZD 500 per annum in pension payments from another country.
- 3. The number of the above who receive less than NZD 300 per annum in pension payments from another country.

Please refer to **Table 1** and **Table 2** in the attached **Appendix** which breaks down the total number of NZS clients who receive overseas pensions from countries with no reciprocal agreement with New Zealand by annualised amounts requested.

I will be publishing this decision letter, with your personal details deleted, on the Ministry's website in due course.
