## Instrument

### 1 Title

This instrument is the Training Incentive Allowance Programme Amendment 2023.

### 2 Commencement

This instrument comes into force 28 days after it is notified in the New Zealand Gazette.

### 3 Programme amended

This instrument amends the Training Incentive Allowance Programme.

### 4 Clause 4 amended (Interpretation)

In clause 4(1), after the definition of **working-age** insert the following definition:

**young person** means a person aged at least 16 years but under the age of 20 years

### 5 Clause 6 amended (Eligibility for assistance)

In clause 6(2), in paragraph (a) after “working-age” insert “or a young person”.

### **Explanatory Note**

This instrument, which comes into force 28 days after it is notified in the New Zealand Gazette, amends the Training Incentive Allowance Programme. The instrument amends the eligibility criteria to allow those aged 16 years and older (provided they meet the relevant eligibility criteria) to receive assistance under the Training Incentive Allowance Programme.
