

Instrument amending Ministerial Directions and Welfare Programmes 2025

This instrument is made under sections 7 and 101 of the Social Security Act 2018 by the Minister for Social Development and Employment.

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Instrument

1 Title

This instrument is the Instrument amending Ministerial Directions and Welfare Programmes 2025.

2 Commencement

This instrument comes into force on 1 April 2025.

3 Principal directions and welfare programmes amended

This instrument amends the directions and welfare programmes specified in Schedules 1 and 2 (the **principal directions and welfare programmes**).

4 Amendments

Amend the principal directions and welfare programmes in the manner set out in Schedules 1 and 2.



Clause 11(1)

In clause 11(1), replace “\$135.75” with “\$138.77” and “\$5,430.00” with “\$5,550.80”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the instrument but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This instrument, which comes into force on 1 April 2025, amends the directions in relation to Special Benefit and Advance Payments of Instalments of Benefit and a number of Ministerial welfare programmes under the Social Security Act 2018:

Clause 4 and Schedule 1:

- adjusts the appropriate income limits in relation to Advance Payments of Instalments of Benefit to reflect the 3.51% increase in the net average wage over the previous year;
- adjusts standard costs, in relation to the direction on Special Benefit to reflect a 2.22% increase in the New Zealand Consumers Price Index (CPI) from the December 2023 quarter to the December 2024 quarter (calculated using the CPI (All Groups)).

Clause 4 and Schedule 2:

- adjusts certain rates and limits in relation to the Employment and Work Readiness Assistance Programme, Family Start and Early Start (Childcare Assistance) Programme, Guaranteed Childcare Assistance Payment Programme, New Employment Transition Grant Programme, Seasonal Work Assistance Programme, and Training Incentive Allowance Programme to reflect a 2.22% increase in the CPI from the December 2023 quarter to the December 2024 quarter (calculated using the CPI (All Groups));
- adjusts the appropriate income limits in relation to the Recoverable Assistance Programme and Special Needs Grants Programme to reflect the 3.51% increase in the net average wage over the previous year;
- the Home Help Programme, to adjust the hourly rate, that may be paid to a home helper, in line with the actual 1.5% increase in the adult minimum wage rate from 1 April 2025 (occurring in line with Cabinet’s decision to increase the minimum wage by 1.5% and then round to the nearest 1 cent);
- the Special Transfer Allowance Programme 2000 to adjust average regional rents to reflect movements in rentals.
