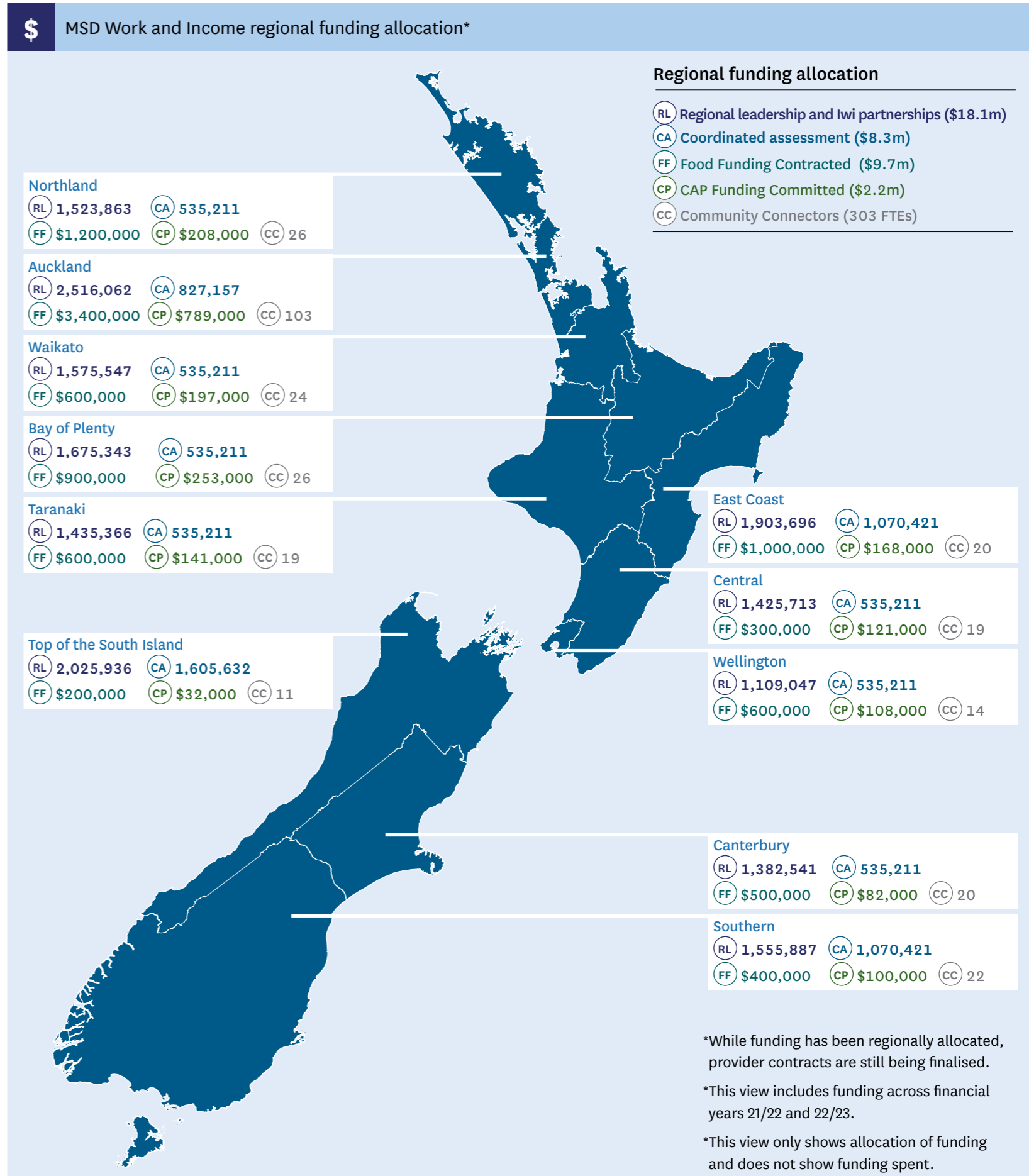

\*To manage MSD's CPF appropriations, funding has been split by MSD Region. The 11 RPSCs will disburse regional leadership group funding for 16 regions based largely on regional and unitary council boundaries noting: Nelson and Tasman operates as one region (agreed by the Mayors) and Chatham Islands operates as a separate regional leadership group.
