

Who we are:

The New Zealand Food Network (NZFN) is a not-for-profit organisation, established with support from the Ministry of Social Development as part of its wider efforts to support all New Zealand communities in becoming food secure.

Our goal is to provide people in need with healthy and nutritious food, through an efficient supply chain designed to share bulk surplus and donated food.

Important information for *Food Hubs:

- Once you've registered with us, you can request pallets of food via our online portal, which is then delivered to you at no cost.
- The amount of food we can make available to you will be determined by our levels of supply, the levels of deprivation / food insecurity in the districts you serve, and your handling capacity.
- You maintain your existing relationships and sources of supply – to be supplemented by contributions from the New Zealand Food Network.

How we work:

We exist to enable food hubs to expand their positive impact in the communities they serve, and beyond, by transforming supply chain processes to create better efficiency and synergy – and eliminating the infrastructure / storage challenges often faced by food hubs around New Zealand.

- 1. We collect quality surplus and donated bulk food from producers, growers and wholesalers around the country.
- 2. We safely store these bulk food donations at our Auckland warehouse, until they're needed.
- 3. We then make food available to be requested on an as-needed basis (and at no cost) by food hubs around the country, via our online portal.



^{*}A Food Hub can be categorised as an entity with the capability of accepting and handling palletised ambient, chilled and frozen product and distributing that product to a wide range of community groups.
