As signalled, please see some brief advice on the attached paper. We don't intend to provide a Min consult briefing on this paper because we don't recommend any feedback, s 9(2)(j) The below information should help in case there are questions on the paper from the Minister or advisors.

- In May, s 9(2)(j) At the same time, Cabinet agreed to the DSS Bill which includes provision to extinguish any pending claims by other family carers that have been filed in the Employment Relations Authority (ERA) and Employment Court, but not resolved or determined, before the commencement date of the Bill.
- There are s 9(2)(h) claims from other family carers that are still unresolved. Since the Bill was introduced, s 9(2)(h) s 9(2)(j)
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- As noted above, s 9(2)(j)
