Extension to the Christchurch Mosques Attack Welfare Programme

Portfolio Social Development and Employment

On 30 March 2022, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee:

- noted that in May 2019, the Cabinet Business Committee agreed to the establishment of the Christchurch Mosques Attack Welfare Programme, under section 101 of the Social Security Act 2018, to ensure that those affected by the Christchurch mosques attacks were able to access financial support, even where their residency status may otherwise have made them ineligible for other assistance from the income support system [CBC-19-MIN-0021];
- 2 noted that the Christchurch Mosques Attack Welfare Programme is currently set to expire on 4 June 2022;
- noted that there are currently nine recipients receiving support through the Christchurch Mosques Attack Welfare Programme who will continue to require support after this date, all of whom are immediate family members of people who were present at the attack;

- 6 agreed to the extension of the Christchurch Mosques Attack Welfare Programme from 5 June 2022 to 30 June 2023;
- 7 **noted** that an extension of the Christchurch Mosques Attack Welfare Programme to 30 June 2023 is estimated to cost \$315,000 in payments to recipients;

8 **approved** the following fiscally neutral transfer to appropriations to give effect to the decision in paragraph 6 above, with no impact on the operating balance and /or net core Crown debt:
