# Supporting Government Partnerships with Maori Through Multi-Year Māori Trades and Training Fund Contracts

Portfolio Social Development and Employment

On 2 March 2022, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee (SWC):

- noted that Ministry of Social Development and Employment (MSD) is supporting 17 Māori employment-focused training programmes, and its ability to financially support these programmes, and fund new ones, is constrained by the current appropriation of funding;
- agreed to an expense transfer from 2021/22 to 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25 to allow MSD to continue supporting multi-year contracts with Māori entities providing by-Māori-for-Māori training to achieve better employment outcomes for Māori;
- **approved** the following changes to appropriations to provide for the above decision, with no impact on the operating balance and/or net core Crown debt across the forecast period:

- agreed that from this point forward, the decision in paragraph 5 above will no longer apply and instead officials from MSD and Te Puni Kōkiri (TPK) will have joint responsibility to approve applications to the Māori Trades and Training Fund;
