

# Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee

### Minute of Decision

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## Social Security (Accommodation Supplement) Amendment Bill: Approval for Introduction

Portfolio Social Development and Employment

On 16 November 2022, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee:

- noted that in June 2022, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee agreed to align Accommodation Supplement legislation with current practice when one member of a couple is in residential care and the other is in the community [SWC-22-MIN-0124];
- agreed to include the Social Security (Accommodation Supplement) Amendment Bill (the Bill) in the 2022 Legislation Programme with a Category 2 priority (to be passed in 2022);
- agreed that the purpose of the Bill is to:
  - 3.1 amend the Social Security Act 2018 and Social Security Regulations 2018 with consequential amendments to the New Zealand Superannuation and Retirement Income Act 2001 and the Veterans' Support Act 2014;
  - 3.2 recognise an individual, whose partner is in long-term residential care, as single for the purpose of calculating entitlement for the Accommodation Supplement;
- 4 **noted** the following forecast changes to the cost of Accommodation Supplement with a corresponding impact on the operating balance and net debt, arising from the finding that the Ministry of Social Development's operational practice in respect of individuals whose partner is in long-term residential care does not align with legislative requirements:

  Amendment Bill [PCO 25060/1.14], subject to the final approval of the Government caucus;
- agreed that the Bill be introduced by 17 November 2022 and passed through all stages under urgency.
