Action to Improve the Sustainability of Disability Support Services

Portfolio Disability Issues

On 4 December 2024, the Cabinet Social Outcomes Committee (SOU):

Rapid review of pricing for residential care

- noted that a freeze, at current levels, is currently in place on funding for residential facility-based care for 2024/25, pending a detailed and urgent review of contract and pricing models:
- 2 directed the Ministry of Social Development to progress a pricing model for funding Disability Support Services (DSS)-funded residential care services, including testing with providers and sector groups of banded rates;
- 3 s 9(2)(f)(iv)
 4 s 9(2)(f)(iv)

Consultation on the implementation of the Independent Review's recommendations, and the scope of longer-term policy work on sustainability

- 5 **approved** the public release of the following discussion documents (the discussion documents), attached to the submission under SOU-24-SUB-0157, in late-February 2025, allowing time for translation into accessible formats:
 - 5.1 Consultation: Targeted Changes to Stabilise Disability Support Services;
 - 5.2 Consultation: Strengthening the System Establishing the scope of work and legislation for a future DSS system;
- 6 authorised the Minister for Disability Issues to make amendments to the discussion documents;
- 7 **invited** the Minister for Disability Issues to report back SOU in May 2025, seeking final decisions for responding to the recommendations 5 and 6 from the Independent Review of DSS, and the scope of longer-term policy work on the future sustainability of DSS;

agreed that the Minister for Disability Issues may publicly communicate the next steps of this work programme, including the expected timeframes.
