New Zealand Superannuation and Veteran's Pension Legislation Amendment Bill: Proposed Policy Changes and SOP

Portfolio Social Development

On 12 February 2020, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee, having been authorised by Cabinet to have Power to Act [CAB-20-MIN-0019]:

- noted that the New Zealand Superannuation and Veteran's Pension Legislation Amendment Bill (the Bill) provides that the non-qualified partner provision will close from 1 July 2020 and spousal deduction will cease from 1 July 2020;
- noted that through the drafting process and the analysis of submissions on the Bill, officials have identified policy changes that need to be made to the Bill to ensure couples' entitlements are clear, and legislation aligns with the policy intent of the modernisation and simplification package agreed to by Cabinet in May 2019 [SWC-19-MIN-0050];
- **noted** that the Office of the Clerk of the House of Representatives has confirmed that these amendments are within the scope of the Bill;

Partner in hospital for more than 13 weeks

agreed that legislation be amended to allow a community-based partner to receive an increased rate of main benefit or Veteran's Pension (VP) or New Zealand Superannuation (NZS) when their partner is hospitalised and receiving a reduced rate of payment under a different Act;

Applying abatement for NZS and VP

- agreed that Schedule 4 of the Social Security Act 2018 be amended to apply:
 - 5.1 Income Test 4 to a Jobseeker Support recipient whose partner receives either NZS or VP;
 - 5.2 Income Test 2 to a Supported Living Payment recipient whose partner receives either NZS or VP;

Direct deduction of overseas pensions received by a superannuitant in respect of or by a dependant

agreed that legislation be amended to ensure that NZS and VP are unaffected by an overseas pension received by or on behalf of a dependant;

agreed that this exemption also apply to any Winter Energy Payments received by superannuitants to be consistent with the approach for spousal deduction;
