On 25 September 2017, you emailed the Ministry requesting information, under the Official Information Act 1982. On 6 October 2017, your request was refined to the following:

- I realised that by definition anyone receiving a Work Capacity certificate for 6 months or more OR receiving a Supported Living Payment by definition have a disability lasting greater than 6 months that would make them eligible for a Disability Allowance. Therefore as a general gauge of whether adequate paperwork is being completed by doctors to maximise support available I'd like to see - if it is possible - what proportion of people in the above situations actually have a disability allowance in place.*

On 24 October 2017, you were notified that the Ministry has interpreted your request to be for information that may indicate at what stage a health practitioner has completed the paperwork for clients granted Supported Living Payment (SLP) or Jobseeker Support Health Condition, Injury or Disability (JS-HCID) to apply for and be granted a Disability Allowance (DA).

When applying for a health related benefit, a client is required to present a medical certificate from an independent health practitioner which states the primary reason they are unable to work and will have deferred work obligations until such time as their health practitioner deems them ready for work. A client may qualify for JS-HCID or SLP depending on the severity of their health condition or disability.

At the time of application for a main benefit, a Case Manager will discuss a client's circumstances to ensure that the client is aware of all financial assistance they may be entitled to. The client can then decide if they wish to apply for any additional financial assistance.

A client may apply to receive a DA to meet any additional costs they may have due to their health condition or disability. DA is an income tested, non taxable form of financial assistance available to people who have on-going additional costs resulting from a disability which is likely to last at least six months. A client is required to complete an application form, have a Disability Certificate completed by their health practitioner and provide verification of any associated costs.

- Table 1 shows the number and percentage of clients granted JS-HCID or SLP for the years ending September 2014 to 2017, broken down by the time to grant a DA in relation to the benefit grant date, of up to 60 days.
- Table 2 shows the number of clients granted JS-HCID or SLP for the years ending September 2014 to 2017, broken down by primary incapacity, and the time to grant a DA in relation to the benefit grant date, of up to 60 days.

In order to protect client privacy, some values are suppressed and are represented by 'S'. The Ministry is unable to provide you with the exact number as releasing this information is likely to risk identifying the individuals concerned. As such, this information is withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the Act. The need to protect the privacy of these individuals outweighs any public interest in this information.

The principles and purposes of the Official Information Act 1982 under which you made your request are:


- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,

- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

Notes for all tables:

- Percentages have been rounded to nearest whole per cent.
- The table includes working age clients only (18 to 64 years).
- Disability Allowance can be paid to a client or on behalf of a partner or dependent child.
- Disability Allowances are paid in respect of costs related to Health Conditions and Disabilities.
- This is a count of JS-HCID & SLP HC&D grants.
- JS-HCID is Jobseeker Support Health Condition, Injury or Disability benefit.
- SLP HC&D is Supported Living Payment Health Condition and Disability
- SLP HC&D does not include Supported Living Payment Carer or Supported Living Payment Overseas.
- The period on the benefit before a DA granted is the period that the client was on the benefit before the Disability Allowance grant date.
- "No DA grant by 60 days" means a Disability Allowance had not been granted within 60 days of the benefit grant date.
- "DA granted same time" means the Disability Allowance grant date was the same date as the main benefit grant date.
- "DA granted 1 to 30 days after benefit grant" means the Disability Allowance was granted within 30 days after the benefit grant date.
- "DA granted 31 to 60 days after benefit grant" means the Disability Allowance was granted between 31 to 60 days after the benefit grant date.
- Primary incapacity is the incapacity recorded for the client receiving the benefit, and may be different than the reason for medical costs paid under the DA.
- 'Unspecified' primary incapacity refers mainly to clients who may not have had an incapacity (medical certificate) recorded in the system at the time of the benefit or DA grant.
- The primary incapacity recorded might not represent the primary incapacity where a client is in receipt of an allowance for a dependant.
- "S" represents a suppressed cell to protect clients privacy
- * Please note: Data for Disability Allowances granted for benefits commenced in the year ending September 2017 is not complete. This is because the 60 day window for checking for Disability Allowance grants had not passed as at extraction date 30 September 2017.
