On 4 February 2020, you emailed the Office of the Hon Carmel Sepuloni, Minister for Social Development, requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

1. *The number of Work and Income clients placed by Work and Income Work Brokers in the Auckland region and in South Auckland for the years 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017 and 2016*
2. *The number of Work and Income clients placed by Work and Income Work Brokers in the Auckland Region and in South Auckland in 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017, 2016 that remained off benefit for 31, 91 and 365 days*
3. *The number of Work Brokers employed by the Work and Income Auckland Region in the years 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016*
4. *The number of Work and Income clients placed by Contracted Services in Auckland and in South Auckland in 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017, 2016*
5. *The number of Work and Income clients placed by Contracted Services in Auckland and in South Auckland in 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017, 2016 that remained off benefit for 31, 91 and 365 days*
6. *The value of Contracted Services placement services in 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016*

Your request for information was transferred to the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) on the same day.

On 20 February 2020, questions two and five of your request were refined to:

2. *The number of Work and Income clients exited by Work and Income Work Brokers in the Auckland Region and in South Auckland in 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017, 2016 that remained off benefit for 31, 91 and 365 days*
5. *The number of Work and Income clients exited by Contracted Services in Auckland and in South Auckland in 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017, 2016 that remained off benefit for 31, 91 and 365 days*

On 20 February 2020, you also clarified the following:

- *By Contracted Services, you mean employment focussed Contracted Services which specifically work with NEET (Not in Employment, Education or Training) clients.*

- *In regards to the value of Contracted Services placement services, you are interested in the Auckland Region and South Auckland.*

On 21 April 2020, the Ministry provided a partial response to your request and advised that the remaining information would be provided as soon as practically possible.

I extend my apologies for the delay in releasing a full response to you.

For the sake of clarity, your questions are addressed in turn below:

1. *The number of Work and Income clients placed by Work and Income Work Brokers in the Auckland region and in South Auckland for the years 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017 and 2016.*

In the Ministry's previous response to you dated 21 April 2020, you were provided with two tables showing the number of employment placements in the Auckland region and in South Auckland during the period 1 January 2016 to 31 December 2019, broken down by calendar year and placement group. The Ministry has revised the way the data is provided in order to keep the data consistent across the response and has now provided you with data which is broken down by financial year.

Table One and **Table Two** below show the number of employment placements in the Auckland region (**Table One**) and in South Auckland (**Table Two**) during the period 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2019, broken down by financial year and placement group.

- The Ministry's regional breakdowns are based on the Ministry Service Centre responsible for the client's case management. A client may not necessarily reside in the same area as their service centre.
- South Auckland is a subset of the Auckland Region and includes the sites Clendon, Hunters Corner, Mangere, Manukau, Manurewa, Otahuhu, Otara, Papakura, Papatoetoe, Pukekohe, and Waiuku.
- The data includes clients of all ages and Benefit types.
- Frontline Work Brokers and Job Connect units work together to place clients into work. The groupings are indicative only and may not reflect the level of collaboration between staff.
- Placements occur via listing and filling vacancies or through clients being assisted into work outside of listed vacancies.
- In certain circumstances, low numbers may potentially lead to individuals being identified. Due to these privacy concerns, the numbers for some categories of clients have been suppressed under section 9(2)(a) of the Act in order to protect the privacy of natural persons. Suppressed numbers have been replaced by an 'S'. The need to protect the privacy of these individuals outweighs any public interest in this information. Secondary suppression rules have also been applied where required.

2. *The number of Work and Income clients exited by Work and Income Work Brokers in the Auckland Region and in South Auckland in 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017, 2016 that remained off Benefit for 31, 91 and 365 days.*

In the Ministry's previous response to you dated 21 April 2020, you were provided with two tables showing work exit sustainability in the Auckland region and in South Auckland broken down by month for the period 1 July 2015 to June 2019. The Ministry has revised the way the data is provided in order to keep the data consistent across the response and has now provided you with data which is broken down by financial year.

Table Three and **Table Four** shows the work exit sustainability in the Auckland Region (**Table Three**) and in South Auckland (**Table Four**) during the period 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2019, broken down by financial year.

- The Ministry's regional breakdowns are based on the Ministry Service Centre responsible for the client's case management. A client may not necessarily reside in the same area as their service centre.
- South Auckland is a subset of the Auckland Region and includes the sites Clendon, Hunters Corner, Mangere, Manukau, Manurewa, Otahuhu, Otara, Papakura, Papatoetoe, Pukekohe, and Waiuku.
- The data includes clients of all ages and Benefit types.
- Sustainability refers to time off Benefit following a work exit, meaning a client may not necessarily remain in employment over this time.
- Please note that Work Brokers are involved in the process of placing clients into paid employment opportunities and are not involved in the action of processing Benefit exits. Therefore, you have been provided with data which is inclusive of all working-age main Benefit work exits. Benefit work exits can happen for any reason and are not restricted to a placement by a Work Broker.
- Further, the Ministry is only able to provide data which is consistent with existing reporting conventions. This enables data to be presented in a clear and concise manner, which can in turn, be easily reconciled against public information presented in the Ministry's online publications and portals.
- The reporting of sustainable exits as a count in numbers is not consistent with the Ministry's standard reporting. The Ministry reports sustainable exits as percentages, as the number of sustainable exits by itself is not a good indicator of success and could lead to misinterpretation. Therefore, the data you are provided is presented in percentages.
- The Ministry does not report on sustainable work exits at 31 days (1 month) as this is not part of the standard reporting procedures. However, the Ministry measures the sustainability of work exits at 91 days (3 months), 182 days (6 months) and 365 days (12 months). This data is being provided to you.
- In order to provide you with data which is consistent with the rest of this response, you have been provided with the data broken down in financial years.

3. *The number of Work Brokers employed by the Work and Income Auckland Region in the years 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016.*

Work brokers discuss potential Work Experience placements with employers or organisations. They also negotiate the agreements with the employer and monitor the placements.

An employment coordinator is a Work and Income employee who works with sole parents, people with a health condition and disabled people to help them find suitable work. Employment coordinators also work with employers and other agencies to ensure clients get the right support.

You have been provided with data on both Work Brokers and Employment Coordinators as this data may be helpful to you.

Table Five and **Table Six** below provide the average number of Work Brokers (**Table Five**) and the average number of Employment Coordinators (**Table Six**) employed by the Work and Income Auckland Region for the period 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2019, broken down by financial year.

In order to provide you with consistent data, we have provided the information in financial years.

In the Ministry's previous response to you dated 21 April 2020, you were provided with two tables showing the number of Work and Income clients placed by Contracted Services in the Auckland region and in South Auckland during the period 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2019, broken down by month. The Ministry has revised the way the data is provided in order to keep the data consistent across the response and has now provided you with data which is broken down by financial year.

Table Seven and **Table Eight** below show the number of Work and Income clients placed by Contracted Services in the Auckland region (**Table Seven**) and in South Auckland (**Table Eight**) during the period 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2019, broken down by financial year.

The Ministry acknowledges that you are interested in employment focussed contracted services which specifically work with NEET clients. However, the data provided does not include clients placed by the Ministry's Youth Service NEET as the service was not focussed on employment until recently. Therefore, this information is refused under section 18(e) of the Official Information Act as this information does not exist or, despite reasonable efforts to locate it, cannot be found. Notes for Tables Seven and Eight

- This data refers to Contracted Service participation starts, reflecting successful client referrals, not a unique count of clients.
- "Participant starts" refers to the total number of clients in Contracted Services, as one participant may have been referred and/or participated in multiple Contracted Services. For instance, in the financial year 2015-2016, 3,396 clients in South Auckland are shown to have participated in Contracted Services, however, some of these clients may be participating in several different Contracted Services.
- Data does not include the Youth Service – Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET).
- Participation starts in South Auckland are based on the client's Service Centre at the time of referral creation.
- The following Contracted Services are included: 'DS - Work Confidence', 'MCA - Be Your Own Boss', 'MCA - Employment Placement or Assistance Initiative', 'MCA - In Work Support', 'MCA - Information Services Initiatives', 'MCA - Intensive Client Support IA Trial Service', 'MCA - Job Search Services', 'MCA - Mainstream Subsidy', 'MCA - New Initiative', 'MCA - Skills for Industry', 'MCA - Skills for Industry (Employer)', 'MCA - Training for Work', 'MCA - Work Ability Assessments', 'MCA - Work Confidence', 'MCA - Work Preparation Services', 'MCA - Work to Wellness Service', 'NI - Regional Economic Development', 'MCA - Mana in Mahi - Strength in Work', 'MCA - Career Guidance and Counselling', 'MCA - Industry Partnership Wage Subsidy', 'MCA - Self Employment Initiatives', 'MCA - Non PATHS', 'MCA - Sector Workforce Engagement

Service', 'DS - Employment Placement or Assistance Initiative', and 'MCA - PATHS Supported Employment'.

- Not all contracted services placements lead to benefit exits. Some support clients to prepare for work.

5. *The number of Work and Income clients exited by Contracted Services in the Auckland Region and in South Auckland in 2019 (to date), 2018, 2017, 2016 that remained off Benefit for 31, 91 and 365 days.*

Notes for Tables Nine and Ten:

- The Ministry's regional breakdowns are based on the Ministry Service Centre responsible for the client's case management. A client may not necessarily reside in the same area as their service centre.
- South Auckland is a subset of the Auckland Region and includes the sites Clendon, Hunters Corner, Mangere, Manukau, Manurewa, Otahuhu, Otara, Papakura, Papatoetoe, Pukekohe, and Waiuku.
- The tables measure working-age main Benefit clients who have been in either employment or work readiness programmes (not including Flexi wage) and have exited Benefit due to obtaining work.
- Flexi wage is a form of subsidised work placement, where the Ministry pays a part of a clients' wage to the employer, to encourage the employer to hire the Ministry client. As this is a placement where a job is specifically acquired rather than a training or up-skilling programme, it is excluded from the figures.
- The results are based on methodology used for external reporting on the "MCA Improved Employment and Social Outcomes Support" appropriation.
- Whereas that measure also includes client participation in Flexi wage, unsubsidised placements, and Quality Engagement with a case manager, the results given only include participation in Contracted Services.
- Sustainability is measured from the date the client has exited the benefit. A client may have participated in more than one Contracted Service in the period in question.

- The values for the financial years 2016 and 2017 cannot be obtained as the core datasets containing information about Contracted Services have not been created going back far enough to evaluate work sustainability. Your request for the 2016 calendar year information is refused under section 18(e) of the Act as this information does not exist or, despite reasonable efforts to locate it, cannot be found.
- The reporting of sustainable exits as a count in numbers is not consistent with the Ministry's standard reporting. The Ministry reports sustainable exits as percentages, as the number of sustainable exits by itself is not a good indicator of success and could lead to misinterpretation. Therefore, the data you are provided is presented in percentages.
- The Ministry does not report on sustainable work exits at 31 days (1 month) as this is not part of the standard reporting procedures. However, the Ministry measures the sustainability of work exits at 91 days (3 months), 182 days (6 months) and 365 days (12 months). This data is being provided to you.
- Please note, that there can be a lag between when a client takes part in a programme and when they exit the Benefit. For instance, a client may do a training programme while still on a Benefit for a couple of weeks, then after completing it, they may take another month to find employment before exiting the Benefit.

6. *The value of Contracted Services placement services in 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016.*

On 20 February 2020, you clarified that you are specifically interested in employment focussed contracted services which specifically work with NEET (Not in Employment, Education or Training) clients. You also clarified that you were interested in contracts from the Auckland Region and national contracts where the provider is Auckland-based.

Please find enclosed **Appendix One**, containing **Table Eleven**, **Table Twelve**, **Table Thirteen** and **Table Fourteen** which show all of the employment focused contracts from the Auckland region and national contracts where the provider is Auckland-based for the 2016 (**Table Eleven**), 2017 (**Table Twelve**), 2018 (**Table Thirteen**) and 2019 (**Table Fourteen**) financial years. The same data was also provided in the Ministry's previous response to you, dated 21 April 2020.

As noted earlier, the Ministry's Youth Service NEET is the only service the Ministry contracts to work specifically with NEET individuals, however this service has only recently become employment focused.

It should also be noted that the Ministry's employment focussed services support a variety of individuals, including those who would be considered NEET. As such any of the employment focused services the Ministry contracts are supporting working age individuals who are not in employment, education or training to upskill for or engage in employment.

The principles and purposes of the Official Information Act 1982 under which you made your request are:

- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,
- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

This Ministry fully supports those principles and purposes. The Ministry therefore intends to make the information contained in this letter available to the wider public. The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter on the Ministry of Social

Development's website. Your personal details will be deleted and the Ministry will not publish any information that would identify you as the person who requested the information.
