On 22 November 2021, you emailed the Office of Hon Peeni Henare, Associate Minister of Housing (Māori Housing) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), a number of reports outlined in written parliamentary question 51201(2021).

On 25 November 2021, the Office of Hon Peeni Henare transferred your request for the following report to the Office of Hon Carmel Sepuloni, the Minister of Social Development and Employment.

REP/21/9/1003 - Requirement to seek fiscally neutral adjustment to enable Te Pokapū Rotorua Housing Hub contract to be finalised, received 17 September.

On 25 November 2021 you were advised that your request for this report was transferred to the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry), as it aligned more closely to the functions of the Ministry.
