## Tēnā koe

On 25 November 2022, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 the following information:

• In the past 12 months, how many \$5k to work grants have been paid?

The \$5k to Work is an incentive payment to assist clients to relocate when they have secured sustainable employment. The job offer must be far enough from the client's current residence that commuting to work would be financially impractical and that without relocating the job seeker would be financially disadvantaged by taking up the employment.

The recipient does not have to be receiving a main benefit from Work and Income, but does need to meet the eligibility criteria for a main benefit, for example Jobseeker Support.

When it is identified that a Work and Income client would benefit from assistance to relocate, staff will proactively advise clients that they may be entitled to the \$5k to Work payment. More information about this payment can be found on the Work and Income website here: www.workandincome.govt.nz/products/a-z-benefits/5k-to-work.html.

Please find attached, as an **Appendix**, an Excel Spreadsheet which contains the number of \$5K to Work grants for the period 1 November 2021 to 31 October 2022.

- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter on the Ministry's website.
