On 23 January 2023, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

1. How much Work and Income has paid out in Funeral Grant payments over the past 3-5 years

2. The total number of Funeral Grant applications Work and Income has received in the past 3-5 years and the number of Funeral Grant applications that Work and Income have approved. Could the number of approved applications be broken down by each region as well please.

3. Does Work and Income against how much funerals cost in different NZ regions

For clarity, each of your questions will be responded to in-turn.

1. How much Work and Income has paid out in Funeral Grant payments over the past 3-5 years

2. The total number of Funeral Grant applications Work and Income has received in the past 3-5 years and the number of Funeral Grant applications that Work and Income have approved. Could the number of approved applications be broken down by each region as well please.

Table One showing the number of Funeral Grant applicationsprocessed between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2022.

Table Two showing the number and amount granted of Funeral Grants approved between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2022, by region.

Please note the following regarding all data provided in the Appendix:

- To protect confidentiality the Ministry uses processes to make it difficult to identify an individual person or entity from published data
- The data tables have had random rounding to base three applied to all cell counts in the table
- Random rounding does not round down to zero, a value of one or two will be rounded to three
- The impact of applying random rounding is that columns and rows may not add exactly to the given column or row totals
- The published counts will never differ by more than two counts.
- *3. Does Work and Income against how much funerals cost in different NZ regions*

This question has been interpretated as does the Ministry compare against how much funerals cost in different New Zealand regions when assessing the amount payable for a Funeral Grant. The Funeral Grant helps with actual and reasonable funeral costs and is not intended to cover the total cost of the funeral. There is a maximum amount that can be paid. The maximum allowable payment for all funeral grants is \$2,280.72, as at 1 April 2022, regardless of the region in New Zealand.
