Official Information Act request

Thank you for your email of 23 July 2024, requesting information on funding to the National Māori Authority.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Please find my decision on your request set out below.

The National Māori Authority received \$1,384,915.28 to deliver the Whakatutuki Work Ready programme between 13 March 2021 and 19 March 2024. This was to provide work readiness training and support services to 97 young people aged 15 to 24 at risk of long-term unemployment, and support 80 into employment, education or training.


They have achieved 73% of the intended enrolments and 59% of the intended outcomes.
