Social Housing Register

- **Table Two:** Number of primary applicants on the Social Housing Register in the Wellington City Territorial Local Authority as at quarter ending March 2018 to September 2024, by total response ethnicity (TRE), and number of bedrooms required.

Emergency Housing

- **Table Three:** Number of households in Emergency Housing in Wellington City Territorial Local Authority as at quarter ending June 2020 to September 2024, by total response ethnicity (TRE), and duration in Emergency Housing.

Please note that point in time emergency housing data can only be provided from April 2020 onwards.


