Official Information Act request

Thank you for your email of 28 November 2024, in which you requested the following information:

I seek the following details regarding emergency housing:

1. As of the 27th of November 2024, how many individuals were covered under emergency housing funding in New Zealand, and how many households do these individuals make up?

2. Could the same information as above be provided for the date of the 1st of December 2023?

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

The Ministry regularly publishes information about Emergency Housing on the Ministry's website. You can find data for the year 2023, broken down by month at the following link:
