### **Official Information Act request**

Thank you for your email of 29 November 2025, requesting information about COVID-19 Wage Subsidy paid to Stuff Limited, including employee information.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Please find my decision on your request set out below.

Information about COVID-19 wage subsidies is available on the employer search webpage, here: <https://services.workandincome.govt.nz/eps/search>.

Stuff applied for the initial subsidy on 15 April 2020, for 907 employees, and received \$6,319,255.20 on 16 April 2020, for the period 15 April 2020 to 7 July 2020.

At the time of the application, 887 of the staff were full time employees, and 20 were part time employees.

Stuff then volunteered to repay \$52,370.52 in June 2020 for ten staff who had resigned or were made redundant during the period covered by the subsidy. I note that repayments were not required to be made for employees who resigned.

A further voluntary repayment of \$55,651.00 was received from Stuff for a further eleven staff that had left to go on parental leave or had resigned.

The total amount repaid was \$108,021.52 for 21 staff.

The Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) did not administer the \$50 million media relief package. This part of your request was transferred to the Ministry for Culture and Heritage for response.

I will be publishing this decision letter, with your personal details deleted, on the Ministry's website in due course.
