Official Information Act request

Thank you for your email of 18 August 2025, requesting data on individuals receiving Disability Support Services (DSS) Residential Disability Support in Auckland and Northland.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Please find my decision on your request set out below.

1. *The number of individuals (split by gender), who are funded by DSS Residential disability support and residing in Aged Residential Care facilities (in Auckland and Northland)*
 - a. *This number split by age (65-55 years, 55-45 years and those under 45 years)*
2. *The number of individuals (split by gender), who are funded by DSS Residential Disability Support and residing in group residential homes (in Auckland and Northland).*
 - a. *This number split by age (Over 65, 65-55 years, 55-45 years and under 45 years)*
3. *The number of individuals (split by gender) with a Physical disability residing in aged residential care facilities (in Auckland and Northland).*
 - a. *This number split by age (over 65 years old, 65-55 years, 55-45 years and under 45 years).*

Please see the attached **Appendix**, containing the following nine tables, detailing the number of individuals receiving Disability Support Services (DSS) Residential Disability Support in Auckland and Northland, as at 31 July 2025:

- **Tables One, Two and Three:** Number of individuals funded by DSS Residential Disability Support in aged residential care in Northland and Auckland as at 31 July 2025, broken down by age, gender, and location.
- **Table Four, Five and Six:** Number of individuals funded by DSS Residential Disability Support in residential group homes in Northland and Auckland as at 31 July 2025, broken down by age, gender, and location.
- **Table Seven, Eight and Nine:** Number of individuals in aged residential care with a physical disability in Northland and Auckland as at 31 July 2025, broken down by age, gender, and location.
